

Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) votes to release a TIP Amendment

The *Cape Cod Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Federal Fiscal Years (FFY) 2013–2016*, originally endorsed on June 25, 2012, was brought back to the MPO on Monday, January 28, 2013, for project cost estimate updates and additions. The Cape Cod MPO released a public **Draft TIP Amendment for FFY 2013-2016** for public review and comment. Changes included in the TIP Amendment to the original TIP are summarized below:
