Fatal/Serious Injuries

All the crashes occurred during daylight conditions.

75% occurred under the jurisdiction of MassDOT

75% occurred along Principal Arterial – Other Roadways

2 single vehicle crashes, 2 angle crashes, 2 rear-end crashes

50% of the crashes contributing factors were either reckless/distracted/impaired

1 collision with tree

Public Comments


- O Need to enforce the "Motorists Give 4 Feet to Pass" for the New Vulnerable Road Users Laws (went into effect April 2023). The law requires motorists to pass a vulnerable road user at a "safe passing distance" of at least 4 feet.
- Need a safe bicyclist crossing along Route 6 to connect Stotts Crossing to High Head Road.
- Need transit amenities (shelters, trash receptables, benches, signs, & etc.) along bus routes.


