Dear Secretary Beaton:

The SEIR provides considerable evidence to suggest that Cedar Pond has been a freshwater pond for a very long time. Its name, Cedar Pond, found on maps as far back as 1880, also suggests that this pond had low- or non-existent salinity levels for over a century, sufficient to support a cedar community in great enough number to provide the basis for the historical name of the pond. The proposed re-installation of the flash boards to manage saltwater intrusion into the pond will support the restoration of this pond from the current brackish to a freshwater system. As presented in the SEIR, currently stressed freshwater vegetation, including red maples and Atlantic white cedars, will benefit from a return to lower salinity levels. In addition, anadromous fish species will benefit from the return of pond water salinity to lower levels. Given this evidence, the proposed restoration is consistent with and supported by wetland performance standards and goals in the Barnstable County Regional Policy Plan.

As this project was required to prepare an EIR, the Cape Cod Commission must review and permit the project, prior to the Town obtaining local permits, licenses and approvals.
