## FUNDING

Funding comes from a combination of state and federal sources, and totals more than \$425 million over the five-year plan.



## TYPICAL PROJECTS

Typical projects include reconstruction of existing intersections or roadways, construction of new multi-use paths, and purchase of new buses to support regional bus service. Projects are designed to address safety and congestion concerns for all transportation modes, including vehicle, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian travel.

CANAL BRIDGES PROGRAM FUNDING		

Approximately \$830 million is programmed on the FFY 2027-2031 TIP for the Canal Bridges Program as part of the Bridge Investment Program and MEGA Discretionary Grant that was awarded by the Federal Highway Administration. The Canal Bridges Program includes replacement of the Sagamore and Bourne Bridges.
